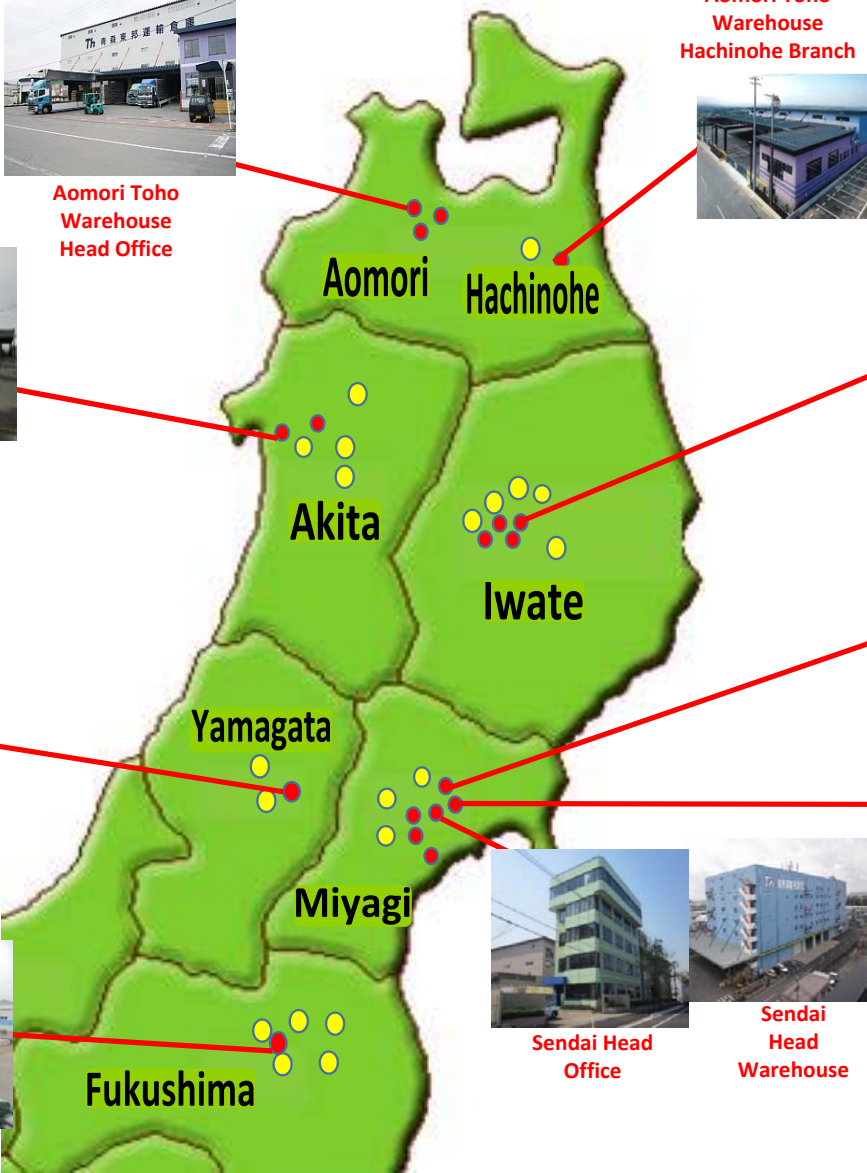

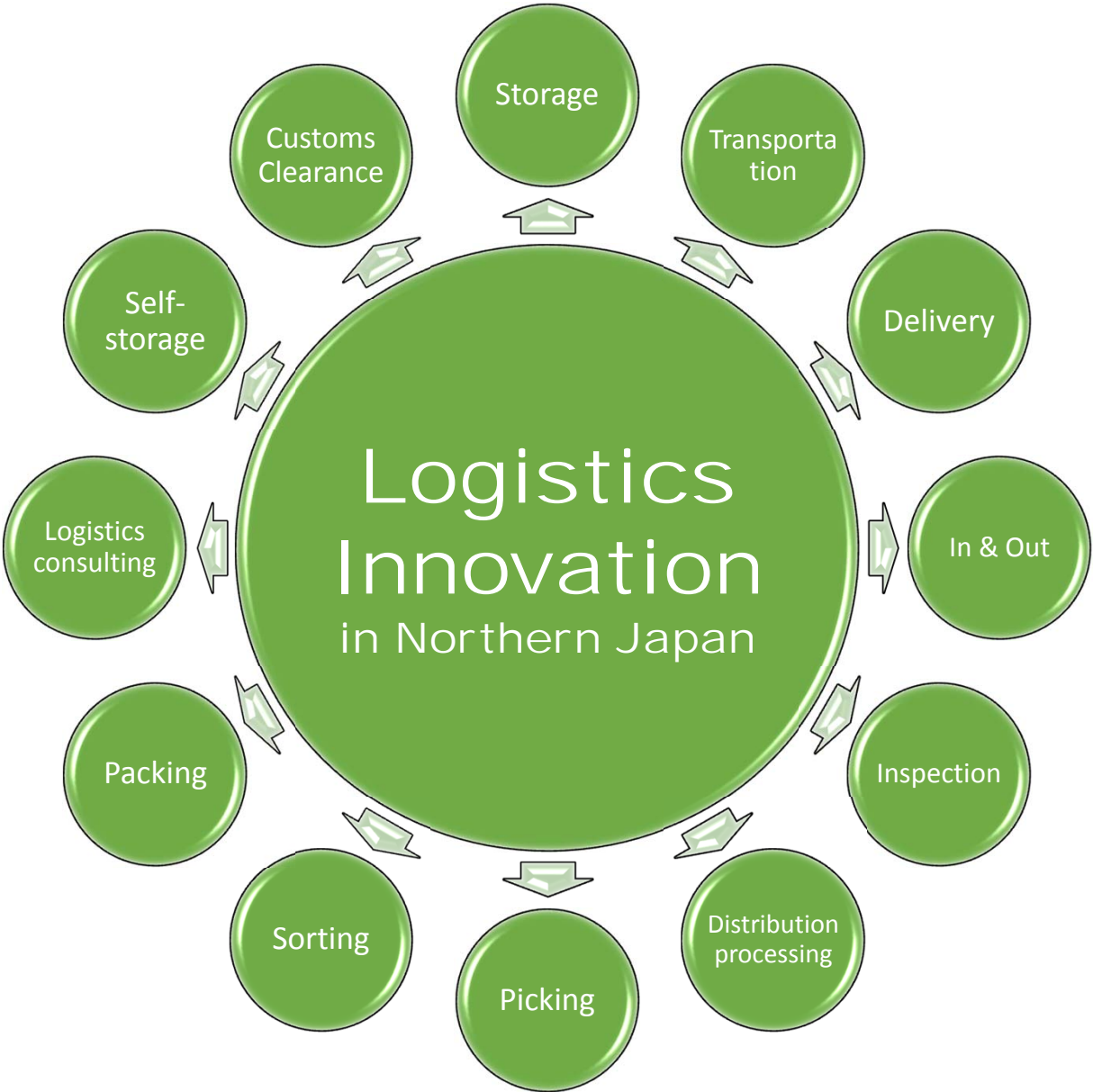

We have won many annual industry competitions in logistics quality for food products as well as construction materials and equipment.

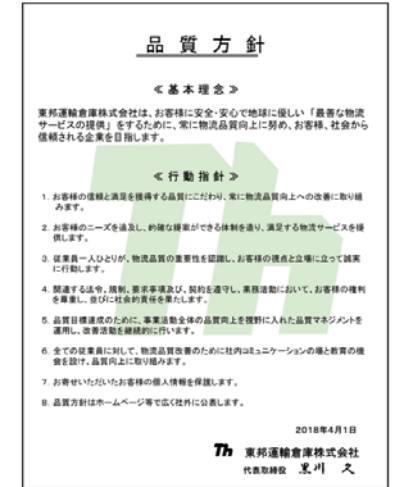
